Please be aware that the Board <u>will not</u> be suspending the teletherapy supervision training requirements based on the Board's statue because it does not have a provision to do so. We do encourage each of you to base your therapy sessions on ethical standards and following HIPPA Guidelines. Exchange of e-mail with clients is usually not confidential and HIPPA compliant, and that needs to be explained to clients. If they choose to communicate with provider that way, they are consenting to taking those risks. Providers are encouraged to only use unsecured electronic messaging of any type for scheduling purposes only, if that.
